Mark Mittry topped the Sling shooters as Sling Match Winner with an excellent 594-31X. Rob Ableson led the Masters with a High Master score of 589-20X. Marco Rojas was top Expert with a Martin Tardif was F-Class Match Winner with a 588-18X. Gene York (fielding his new Seb Mini with all the tasty Blake upgrades) was first Master with a 570.13. Greg Martinez took the Expert category with a 544-6X.

Thanks to all the shooters for helping to run an efficient and safe match. When there is an issue like a shooter equipment malfunction or crossfire sometimes other competitors can become impatient but I think due to the efficiency of the E-targets the atmosphere is much more relaxed and problems can be analyzed and overcome without undue stress.
