We had 20 shooters registered for this match. There were 2 no-shows and 2 shooters ended up not shooting or could not finish, leaving 16 total. We started with 5 targets but due to unreliable shot quality from the 5th target we reshuffled the squadding for only 4 targets. Even with a late start at 8:30 we were done shooting by 1:30. Each Match averaged 1hr./40 minutes.

The conditions were extremely variable the whole day. The flags were visibly in disagreement and the mirage switched constantly. Some of us went with the mirage and those flags that could confirm what the mirage was doing. Personally, I waited for left to right wind and confirmed with the 100 and 750 yard flags. I have found the usual conditions at our range to be right to left and confirmed with the 200 and 400 yard flags while also being aware of the 100 yard 'wild card' flag.

John Stewart took 3rd place in F-Class and Sam Berg was 3rd in Sling. Martin Tardif placed 2nd in F while Jeff Mendoza did the same in Sling. Damon Martin topped the F-Class squad with a 583-18x, the only High Master score for the F'ers and Marc Mittry was overall high score with 588-25x.

I want to thank Mark Bower for helping set up the targets and confirming target response and shot quality. He's the undeniable ShotMarker guru for BRRC. He also helped run the match and kept it flowing when we had the #5 target failure. Jeff M. was a big help with setup as well. Sam and Dave (no, not that Sam and Dave) Berg were invaluable when it came time to break down and stow the targets and tech and Marc M collected the flags. Always nice to get quality help with the grunt work.

It was really fun to have 3 new shooters show up for SoCals only regular 1,000 yard highpower match. Damon Martin and John Stewart, 2 champion shooters, came all the way from San Diego to attend (we do have other San D shooters as well). Francesca Berg (yes, one of those Bergs) made a good showing with a 548-8x. That's a solid Expert score. Props to Francesca.

This match was very challenging as confirmed by the scores but that's just part of the game as we all know. So let's suck it up and move on to the next match...which, by the way will be held on Sunday, May 23.
