The new target frames are performing nearly flawlessly with the occasional 'ghost' shot the only hiccup (@1 or 2 per 1500 shots recorded).

Randy T. ran away the from the rest of us on the first stage of the match with a stellar 199-7x, left us in the dust and heat and never looked back, 593-28x. Kurt I. came closest to catching up to him with the only other High Master score of the day, 584-19. John Stewart made a come from behind surge in the 3rd stage to top the wind baffled F-Class shooters with 581-17x. Special mention to Alex D. for top EX/SS. It was hot work from set up to take down. Elapsed time from first to last shot for the match was 5-1/2 hrs.
