14	<p>Saturday conditions started out with mild breezes and cloudy skies and increased incrementally to moderately gusty (just in time for the 1K yard stage). This match was shot from the High-power line from 200 to 1,000 yards. Stage-1 Barricade - 200 yards, 9 shots: 4 weak side, 5 strong side form wood barricade at 5"x8" torso on 8.5x11 paper. We mixed it up this time by shooting 'weak' side first. That way you had to plow through the hard shots with a 150sec/par. Henry had high score.</p> <p>Stage-2 Spinner - @240(?) yards, 10 shots at the newish spinner target in 60sec/par. Get the target to spin (from 2 to 3 shots) and keep it spinning. Each revolution worth 1 point. Alex, our newest hungry newbie, did a smack down on the rest of us with 17 revolutions. Welcome to the addiction, Alex.</p> <p>Stage-3 KYL - Shot at 383 yards. 10 shots at 5 lollipop swingers from @10" to 2" in 60sec/par. 15 points to clean the rack and if you clean the rack you can start over and get another 15 points. Geoffrey cleaned it on the first pass and went back for seconds. He wisely stopped short of the 10th shot and kept the 25 points. Well done, G</p> <p>Stage-4 Timed Exposure - Shot at 600 yards. 5 shots at colored 8.5x11 paper targets on 1x2x6' sticks exposed for 3sec., 5 times. 5 points possible. Darren and Steve each snagged 3 points (in gusty conditions).</p> <p>Stage-5 Movers - Still at 600 yards. IPSC torsos on sticks moving at 3fps. - 5/12 sec. exposures. 15 points possible. James and Geoffrey took high score in gusty conditions.</p> <p>Stage-6 1,000 yards - Shot at 1,000 yards, 10 shots, 60sec/par, 12" round steel plate. Henry Garay, again makes a mockery of the "Heavy Hitter" 6mm, 6.5mm and .30 cal. shooters with his 75gr., .223 pea shooter. We salute you, Henry.</p> <p>Congratulations to Geoffrey Tyndall, Match Winner. Very impressive score. I want to thank all the competitors that came out and those that helped set up and take down the targets as well as those that helped setting up the picnic benches afterward for the Club BBQ to be held the next day. Next match is tentatively set for July 23rd. Thinking of doing the walk back. Details will follow.</p>
