Warm weather greeted the shooters yesterday. I was told it got up to 95*! Some light breezes mostly from 6:00 did little damage.

Stage 1) Pistols on steel. 12 shots total w/mag change . Start prone and advance to next target, shoot from target position to next target position, change mag at 6th position and move back to 1st prone shot (holstering pistol before moving back between stations). Timed from 1st shot to last for tie breaking. 12 points possible (pp). **Mark** showed us how it's done with 10 hits

Stage 2) Rifle on steel. Same steel targets but shot from the first pistol position (prone). 6pp-Shot from closest to furthest (@60yds. to 180yds.) kneel, kneel, prone, prone, kneel, prone 90 sec.par. **Ray** and **Alex** blazed through this stage, both cleaned it.

Stage 3) Rifle on steel spinner from top of 600yd impact berm to 1,000yd plateau (320yds). 10 shots/1min. par, 10pp. From sitting w/tripod, shoot bottom, top, bottom, top, etc. **Alex** cleaned this stage handily.

Stage 4) Rifle on steel. Prone from 600yd berm to 1,000yd plateau (400yds) 45sec. par. 6pp. Target sizes from 6 to 12 inches, from 380yds. to 415yds. **Ray** and **Jeff** put the hurt on that steel with cleans.

Stage 5) Rifle on steel. Prone from 380yd berm to 1,000yd plateau (620yds) 90sec. par. 12pp. Target sizes from 6 to 12 inches, from 580yds. to 615yds. **Ray** and **Alex** didn't clean it but put the fear of swift justice into most of those targets. Both were 9 of 12.

Stages 6 and 7) Rifle on paper. Prone from the 200yd flag to the 600yd target line (400yds).

Stage 6) Timed exposure, 5shots, 8.5x11 inch paper on sticks presented at random positions along the 600yd target berm for 3 sec., 5 times - 5pp. **Darren**, **Steve** and **Geoff** cleaned this little stage.

Stage 7) Movers, where fortunes are made...and lost. IPSC Torsos presented at random positions along the 600yd target line and move at a fast patrol pace-2FPS 5-12sec. exposures, 15pp. **Steve** and **Darren** cleaned this stage like the Bosses they are.

Steve Goldman MW again KO's the competition while playing the dark horse by coming in second on 5 of 7 stages and slams the door on the on the 6th and 7th. Well done, Steve (next time that lucky hat will be for RENT!)

Thanks to all the challengers and keep a weather eye for the next Tactical Challenge. It's scheduled for late November but i will see if I can move it to early December. No COF is set so let me know what you lot would like to see.
