Stage 1 Long Range

120 Sec. Par Time

10 Rounds

Equipment: Any

Shooter Starts Standing MBB

On the beep shooter must engage 6" circle at 300 Yards and the middle plate at the 400 yard rack the IPSC at the 600 yard berm, the 700-800 12" circle and the 1k large plate with 2 rounds each.

Stage 2 Ladder Stage

90 Sec. Par time

10 Rounds

Shooter starts standing MBB

On the beep shooter must engage the 8" circle at the 400 yard berm and the 12" circle 600 yard berm with 1 round each and then move to a different rung on the ladder and repeat the process until time expires or you are out of ammo.

Stage 3 KYL set around 350 yards

60 sec. Par time

10 rounds

Shooter starts standing MBB

On the beep the shooter drops to prone and must engage the targets Largest to smallest.

If at any time the shooter misses, he or she must start over with all points lost. Shooter can stop at any time and bank points.

Stage 4 Tank trap

60 Sec. Par time

8 rounds

Shooter Starts Standing MBB

On the Beep shooter must engage the 8" circle plate at the 400 yard berm with 2 rounds from each Tip of the tank trap and finish at the cradle

Stage 5 Roof Top

120 Sec. Par Time

10 Rounds

Equipment Any

Shooter Starts 3 steps back behind the roof top.

At the beep shooter must engage the 6" plate at 200 yards, the 300 yard small plate and the 600 yard IPSC then back to 300 and 200 with 2 rounds each. NO part of the shooter must contact the ground.

Stage 6 Positional

120 Sec. Par Time

12 Rounds

Equipment: Sling only

Shooter Starts Standing MBB

At The beep shooter must engage the Large Plate at the 200 Yard Berm with 3 shots from each of the positions. Standing, Kneeling, Sitting and unsupported prone.

Stage 7 PRS Stage

90 Sec. Par Time

6 Rounds

Rifle on the ground MIBB

Shooter Starts Standing 10 Paces behind rifle. At the beep shooter runs to rifle and must engage the IPSC targets at the 400 yard berm in the order of Left-Middle-Right-Right-Middle-Left. This is the tie breaker stage!! Shoot Fast
